Avoiding Lens Scratches:

- External Lens scratches or marks are a non-warranty service item.
- Scratches on the objective or ocular lenses are usually caused by rubbing dirt into the optical coating with a cloth or rag.
- Scratches are permanent, yet they are easily preventable.
- Be extremely cautious when removing dirt, dust or debris. Compressed air or a dust blower often works best for dirt and dust.
- Most minor lens scratches will not hinder the performance of the optics.
